### GETTING TO & FROM THE CONCERT

#### **CATCH A BUS OR TRAIN!**

We strongly recommend you use public transport to get to nib Stadium. All Transperth services are included with the ticket for 3 hours before and after the event.

Catch the **TRAIN** to Claisebrook station and then walk 400 metres to nib Stadium.

Alternatively catch a **BUS**. The closest bus stops to the stadium are located on Lord St and Beaufort St.

If you must drive, **PARKING** around nib Stadium is very limited with most areas restricted to Residents Only.

Make sure you leave plenty of time to get to the venue & check transport timetables ahead of time!

### WEATHER

Eagles concert will proceed rain or shine.

*Please note, umbrellas may not be brought into the venue*

### BOX OFFICE & TICKET COLLECTION

Box offices are located at Gates 1, 3 and 4 and will open from 5:45pm on the day of the show only.

However, to avoid queues on the day of the show patrons are encouraged to collect their pre-purchased tickets in advance from a Ticketmaster outlet.

### FOOD & BEVERAGES

nib Stadium is fully licensed and has a great range of food and drink to satisfy all your needs. Please see food outlet and bar locations on the attached map.

### NO PASS OUTS

Pass outs will not be permitted. Once you leave the venue you may not re-enter.

### NO SMOKING

nib Stadium is a Smoke Free venue. Patrons are not permitted to smoke within the venue.

### NO VIDEO CAMERAS

The use of cameras and mobile phones as filming or recording devices is not permitted. Thank you for your cooperation.

### GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

#### PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Umbrellas, tarps, blankets and chairs.
- Professional cameras (with detachable lenses), video cameras, or audio recorders with external microphones as well as digital recorders
- Flares, fireworks, laser pointers
- Loud hailers
- Umbrellas and sun/rain shelters
- Alcoholic beverages & Illicit drugs
- Cans (including aerosol cans) & glass (including perfume bottles, containers, glass drink bottles & glasses)

- Flagpoles and banners larger than A4
- Bags, prams and strollers that cannot be stored underneath a standard venue seat.
- Animals (guide dogs excepted)
- Articles displaying offensive or political messages
- Any items, including musical instruments, deemed to be either a danger or nuisance to either yourself or others.
- Any item that might be used as a projectile such as glow sticks, balls, fireworks, etc.

***\*Please note prohibited items will not be allowed into the venue. If in doubt, leave it at home!***

### VIP PLATINUM TICKET HOLDERS

VIP Platinum ticket holders will enter nib Stadium via Gate 1. Once inside the stadium, please make your way to the dedicated Platinum Merchandise Stand which will be located inside Gate 1. Here you will be able to purchase souvenirs and collect your Platinum Pack including your drink voucher. Please collect your Platinum Pack before 7:20pm. Your Platinum Package is redeemable on presentation of your concert ticket.
